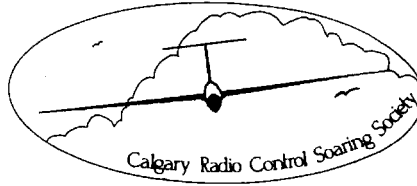


# Alberta Soaring Championships

**Registration:** 8-9 am Saturday with first round starting at 09:30 am. Last round starts Sunday by 2:00 pm.

**Classes:** Open (expert and competitor), 2 meter, RES

**Tasks:** 3 minute Precision followed by one round each of 5 PD and 7 PD. Followed by CD's choice. Standard landing lines.

Launch window for each round. 12 volt winchs and retrievers.

**Trophies:** Open (expert & competitor), 2 meter and RES to third place.

**Contest Fees:** All classes \$20. (Cdn. Funds/fee covers both days)

**Directions to Field:** From McLeod Trail (old hwy #2) turn on Hwy 22X (Marquis de Lorne Trail) and go west past Spruce Meadows Equestrian center. Turn left at Red Deer Lake School and drive approx. 1.5 km to Lloyd Park. Drive slowly through the park to the turn-around at the end of the road and follow the signs to the field. Don't hesitate to call or e-mail the CD if further details are required.
